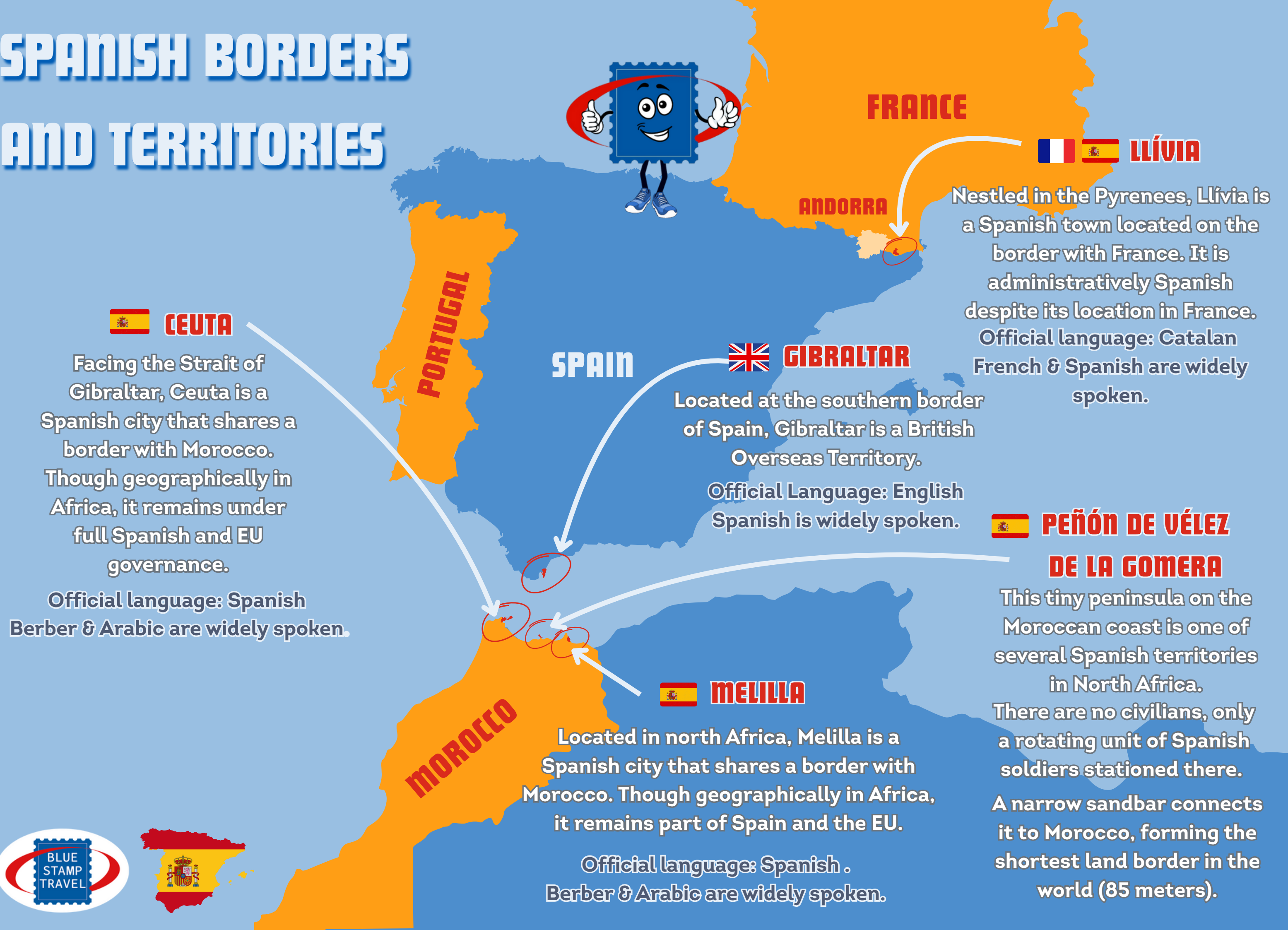


SPANISH BORDERS AND TERRITORIES



CEUTA

Facing the Strait of Gibraltar, Ceuta is a Spanish city that shares a border with Morocco. Though geographically in Africa, it remains under full Spanish and EU governance.

Official language: Spanish
Berber & Arabic are widely spoken.

**PEÑÓN DE VÉLEZ

This tiny peninsula on the Moroccan coast is one of several Spanish territories in North Africa. There are no civilians, only a rotating unit of Spanish soldiers stationed there. A narrow sandbar connects it to Morocco, forming the shortest land border in the world (85 meters).



MELILLA

Located in north Africa, Melilla is a Spanish city that shares a border with Morocco. Though geographically in Africa, it remains part of Spain and the EU.

Official language: Spanish.
Berber & Arabic are widely spoken.
