
## SPANISH BORDERS

This tiny peninsula on the Moroccan coast is one of several Spanish territories in North Africa.

There are no civilians, only a rotating unit of Spanish soldiers stationed there.

A narrow sandbar connects it to Morocco, forming the shortest land border in the world (85 meters).
