## **Dear Student and Parent/Carer**

Blue Stamp Travel organise Summer Camps (for all ages) and Language Courses and Work Experience for 6<sup>th</sup> form students in France, Germany, Italy and Spain, and provide trips for in excess of 2000 students each year across Europe and beyond. They are both ABTA and ATOL accredited and have knowledgeable and multilingual staff (including ex-teachers and school leaders) who are available to help and advise students, teachers and parents/carers before and during their stay, as necessary.

Students enrol to Blue Stamp independently via their website and are able to choose the destination and dates for their travel. (When a student enrols a parent/carer account is also created.)

Summer camps are available for students from 11+ including separate camps for young adults 15 - 18, and intensive language courses for students 16+. Students 16+ can also combine an intensive course with a work placement in the afternoons on the Work and Study package.

Blue Stamp's partner language schools are all accredited and offer exceptional quality in their teaching of <French / German / Italian / Spanish>. Work placements are provided from a range of <u>business categories</u>.

Accommodation is recommended in vetted homestays. These provide an excellent opportunity for further immersion in the language and culture. Some destinations also offer residence accommodation and shared apartments belonging to the schools.

Travel is arranged independently meaning you have flexibility of which airports and what time flights you choose. Blue Stamp can advise further on this as required. Transfers can be included on arrival.

All students need to book with Blue Stamp directly before <insert date 12 weeks prior to travel>. Students can travel with a friend or a small group of friends. Each student enrols independently and Blue Stamp will group them accordingly.
